## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The closing paragraph of subdivision 1 of section 1202-s of the tax law, as added by section 1 of part T of chapter 406 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as follows:

The rates of such tax shall not exceed [three] five percent of the per diem rental rate for each room, provided however, that such tax shall not be applicable to a permanent resident of a hotel or motel. For the purposes of this section the term "permanent resident" shall mean a person occupying any room or rooms in a hotel or motel for at least thirty consecutive days.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2020.

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
