AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the definition of
qualified agencies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 9 of section 835 of the executive law, as separately amended by chapters 14 and 155 of the laws of 2012, is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 9. "Qualified agencies" means courts in the unified court system, the
4 administrative board of the judicial conference, probation departments,
5 sheriffs' offices, district attorneys' offices, the state department of
6 corrections and community supervision, the department of correction of
7 any municipality, the financial frauds and consumer protection unit of
8 the state department of financial services, the office of professional
9 medical conduct of the state department of health for the purposes of
10 section two hundred thirty of the public health law, the child protective
11 services unit of a local social services district when conducting
12 an investigation pursuant to subdivision six of section four hundred
13 twenty-four of the social services law, the office of Medicaid inspector
14 general, the temporary state commission of investigation, police forces
15 and departments having responsibility for enforcement of the general
16 criminal laws of the state, the Onondaga County Center for Forensic
17 Sciences Laboratory when acting within the scope of its law enforcement
18 duties and the division of forensic services of the Nassau county
19 medical examiner's office when acting within the scope of its law
20 enforcement duties and public defenders, legal aid societies, and
21 assigned counsel administrators.

22 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
