- AN ACT to amend the executive law and the education law, in relation to prohibiting race discrimination based on natural hairstyles

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 292 of the executive law is amended by adding two new subdivisions 37 and 38 to read as follows: 2 37. The term "race" shall include, but not be not limited to, ances-3 4 try, color, ethnic group identification, and ethnic background, and 5 shall include traits historically associated with race, including but б not limited to, hair texture and protective hairstyles. 38. The term "protective hairstyles" shall include, but not be limited 7 8 to, such hairstyles as braids, locks, and twists. § 2. Section 11 of the education law is 9 amended by adding two new 10 subdivisions 9 and 10 to read as follows: 11 9. "Race" shall include, but not be not limited to, ancestry, color, 12 ethnic group identification, and ethnic background, and shall include 13 traits historically associated with race, including but not limited to, hair texture and protective hairstyles. 14 10. "Protective hairstyles" shall include, but not be limited to, such 15 16 hairstyles as braids, locks, and twists. 17 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
