AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to expanding the scope of unlawful discriminatory practices to include public education institutions

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 35 of section 292 of the executive law, 2 added by a chapter of the laws of 2019, amending the executive law relating to expanding the scope of unlawful discriminatory practices to include public education institutions, as proposed in legislative bills numbers A. 3425 and S. 4901, is amended to read as follows:

[35.] 37. The term "educational institution" shall mean:

- (a) any education corporation or association which holds itself out to the public to be [non-secretarian] non-sectarian and exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of article four of the real property tax 10 law; or
- (b) any public school, including any school district, board of cooper-11 12 ative [education] educational services, public college or public university. 13
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 15 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2019, amending the executive law 16 relating to expanding the scope of unlawful discriminatory practices to include public education institutions, as proposed in legislative bills 18 numbers A. 3425 and S. 4901, takes effect.
