AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to providing that a correction officer of the county of Oswego need not be a resident of such county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new subdivision 68 to read as follows: <u>68. In the county of Oswego, the provisions of this section requiring</u>

4 <u>a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal</u> 5 <u>corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within</u> 6 <u>which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall</u> 7 <u>not prevent a person from holding the office of correction officer for</u> 8 <u>the county of Oswego, provided that such person resides in Oswego county</u> 9 <u>or an adjoining county within the state of New York; provided, however,</u> 10 <u>that any person performing such functions or holding the office of</u> 11 <u>correction officer in any other county shall be a resident of such coun-</u> 12 <u>ty unless otherwise provided by an act of the state legislature.</u>

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
