AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to change of enrollment by previously registered voters

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 5-304 of the election law, as 2 amended by chapter 90 of the laws of 1991, is amended to read as 3 follows:

- 3. A change of enrollment received by the board of elections not later than the twenty-fifth day before the general election shall be deposited in a sealed enrollment box, which shall not be opened until the first Tuesday following such general election. Such change of enrollment shall be then removed and entered as provided in this article; provided however, in the year before a presidential election, if a previously registered voter files a change of enrollment or a new enrollment after the twenty-fifth day before the general elections and no later than the day before the first day to circulate a petition for the presidential primary, such change of enrollment or new enrollment shall take effect immediately.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
