AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to establishing a statewide restaurant meals program as part of the supplemental nutrition assistance program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 95 of the social services law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:
- 11. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
- 4 the office shall establish a statewide restaurant meals program as part 5 of SNAP. Under the restaurant meals program, households containing
- 6 elderly or disabled members, and their spouses, as defined in 7 U.S.C.
- 7 2012(j), or homeless individuals, as defined in 7 U.S.C. 2012(1), shall have the option in accordance with 7 U.S.C. 2012(k) to redeem their SNAP
- benefits at private establishments that contract with the office to 9
- 10 offer meals for eligible individuals at concessional prices subject to 7
- U.S.C. 2018(h). 11
- 12 (b) The office shall adopt any rules necessary to implement the
- 13 provisions of this subdivision.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-15 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
