AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to designating St. Regis river as an inland waterway for the purposes of waterfront revitalization

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as amended by chapter 499 of the laws of 2018, is amended to
2 read as follows:

4 (b) the state's major rivers comprised of the Allegheny, Ausable,
5 Battenkill, Black, Boquet, Bronx, Canisteo, Chaumont (including Chaumont
6 bay), Chemung, Chenango, Cohocton, Delaware, Deer, Genesee, Grasse,
7 Great Chazy, Hoosic, Hudson north of the federal dam at Troy, Indian,
8 Little (in the Adirondack park), Little Ausable, Little Salmon (including
9 north and south branches), Mad, Mettowiee, Mohawk, Oswegatchie, Oswego,
10 Pocantico, Racquette, Sacandaga, Salmon, Saranac, Saw Mill, Schroon,
11 St. Regis, Susquehanna, Tenmile, Tioga, Tioughnioga, Wallkill and
12 Buffalo rivers, and the north and middle branches of the Moose river;

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
