AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring local veterans' service agencies to provide information to the division of veterans' services on an annual basis

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 24 of section 353 of the executive law, as 2 added by a chapter of the laws of 2019 amending the executive law relat-3 ing to the listing of county and city veterans' service agencies, as 4 proposed in legislative bills numbers S.2405 and A.4413, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 24. To maintain a listing on the division's website of the local 7 veterans' service agencies established pursuant to section three hundred 8 fifty-seven of this article with the name, location, hours of operation 9 and contact information of each county and city veterans' service agen-10 cy. The division shall also provide this information in its annual 11 report to the governor and the legislature as required pursuant to 12 subdivision eleven of this section. Information under this subdivision 13 shall be [maintained and] provided to the division by each local veter-14 ans' service agency and shall be updated annually.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 16 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2019 amending the executive law 17 relating to the listing of county and city veterans' service agencies, 18 as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.2405 and A.4413, takes 19 effect.
