AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to the annual report of the division of criminal justice services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 4-c and 12 of section 837 of the executive
2 law, subdivision 4-c as added by chapter 107 of the laws of 2000 and
3 subdivision 12 as added by chapter 399 of the laws of 1972 and as renum-
4 bered by chapter 603 of the laws of 1973, are amended to read as
5 follows:

6 4-c. In cooperation with the chief administrator of the courts as well
7 as any other public or private agency, including law enforcement agen-
8 cies, collect and analyze statistical and all other information and data
9 with respect to the number of hate crimes reported to or investigated by
10 the division of state police, and all other police or peace officers,
11 the religion, race, ethnicity, age, sex, and the sexual orientation and
12 gender identity of the victim or victims of such crimes, the number of
13 persons arrested for the commission of such crimes, the offense for
14 which the person was arrested, the county within which the arrest was
15 made and the accusatory instrument filed, the disposition of the accusa-
16 tory instrument filed, including, but not limited to, as the case may
17 be, dismissal, acquittal, the offense to which the defendant pled guilt-
18 ty, the offense the defendant was convicted of after trial, and the
19 sentence imposed. The division shall include the statistics and other
20 information required by this subdivision in the annual report submitted
21 to the governor and legislature pursuant to subdivision twelve of this
22 section.

23 12. Make an annual report no later than March first of each year to
24 the governor and legislature concerning its work during the preceding
25 year, and such further interim reports to the governor, or to the gover-
26 nor and legislature, as it shall deem advisable, or as shall be required
27 by the governor;

28 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
