- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to creating a state-wide literacy education advocacy program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new
2	subdivision 57 to read as follows:
3	57. The commissioner shall develop a literacy education advocacy
4	program to provide additional literacy instruction for elementary
5	school-aged children. Such program shall:
б	a. foster collaborative relationships among not-for-profit organiza-
7	tions that increase the capacity for programming aimed at urban chil-
8	dren, youth, and families;
9	b. serve as an incubator of innovation, enabling participating organ-
10	izations to employ their expertise to implement programs of value to the
11	<u>community;</u>
12	c. be optional for school districts across New York state; and
13	d. utilize the study performed by the commissioner on the Newburgh
14	Armory Unity Center Literacy Education Advocacy Partnership.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
