Introduced by M. of A. GALEF -- read once and referred to the Committee on Election Law

AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to establishing mobile polling places for early voting

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 8-600 of the election law is amended by adding a  
2 new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

3 2-a. (a) In addition to the designation of polling places required by  
4 subdivision two of this section, a county board of elections may estab-  
5 lish two or more locations for mobile polling places for early voting,  
6 provided that the maximum number of locations a county may establish for  
7 such mobile polling places shall be determined by the state board of  
8 elections based on population.

9 (b) Locations for mobile polling places for early voting shall be  
10 selected to provide the maximum number of voters in a county with  
11 adequate access to early voting, taking into consideration population  
12 density, travel time to the polling place, proximity to other early  
13 voting poll sites, public transportation routes, commuter traffic  
14 patterns and such other factors the board of elections deems appropri-  
15 ate.

16 (c) Locations for mobile polling places for early voting shall be  
17 operational for no fewer than three consecutive days.

18 (d) No mobile polling place for early voting established by this  
19 subdivision shall replace or otherwise decrease the number of polling  
20 places for early voting required by subdivision two of this section.

21 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
