AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to notice of art stolen during the Nazi era in Europe

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 233-aa of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 15 to read as follows:
- 15. Every museum which has on display any identifiable works of art known to have been created before nineteen hundred forty-five and which changed hands due to theft, seizure, confiscation, forced sale or other involuntary means in Europe during the Nazi era (nineteen hundred thirty-three--nineteen hundred forty-five) shall prominently place a placard
- 7 ty-three--nineteen hundred forty-five) shall prominently place a placard 8 acknowledging such information along with such display.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
