AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to prohibiting certain pre-K programs from requiring the influenza vaccine for children entering such programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 2164 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 9 to read as follows:
- 9. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no person in parental relation to a child in this state entering or having entered a child care, head start, nursery, 3-K or pre-K program or a comparable program for children age six months through fifty-nine months, shall be required to have administered to such child an immunization against influenza.
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
