AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to creating a pedestrian safety rating system for motor vehicles

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 216-b to read as follows:
- § 216-b. Pedestrian safety rating system. The commissioner shall cause to be created a pedestrian safety rating system which shall be made publicly available on the department's internet website. Such pedestrian safety rating system shall provide a rating between one and five stars for every motor vehicle model registered by individuals in this state based on:
- 9 <u>1. the frequency of collisions involving a bicyclist or pedestrian</u>
 10 reported in the state for such motor vehicle model, compared to the
 11 total number of such motor vehicle model registered in the state;
- 2. safety features that the commissioner determines are relevant to
 pedestrian and bicyclist safety, including but not limited to, automatic
 collision warning or pedestrian detection features, automatic braking,
 and visibility; and
- 3. any other factors the commissioner determines are relevant to pedestrian and bicyclist safety.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
