AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the regents establishing a process for colleges to become universities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 216-d

4	establish a process for colleges to be allowed to become a university
5	where the college:
б	a. is authorized by the regents to offer at least the following:
7	<u>(i) a range of undergraduate programs;</u>
8	(ii) fifteen master's programs; and
9	<u>(iii) one doctoral program; and</u>
10	b. meets or exceeds any other requirement deemed necessary by the
11	regents.
12	2. Upon application by a college meeting the requirements in subdivi-
13	sion one of this section, the regents shall, in a timely manner, make a
14	decision regarding the application of the college.
