AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting rental vehicle companies from imposing any fees, charges or penalties, other than the actual cost of a toll, on an authorized driver for such driver's use of a rental vehicle

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 396-Z of the general business law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 13-b to read as follows:

13-b. A rental vehicle company shall not impose any fees, charges or 4 penalties, other than the actual cost of a toll, on an authorized driver for such driver's use of a rental vehicle through a toll collection facility that utilizes an electronic toll collection system, as defined in section twenty-nine hundred eighty-five of the public authorities law, or a photo-monitoring system for the payment of tolls.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 10 have become a law; provided that the amendments to section 396-Z of the 11 general business law made by section one of this act shall survive the 12 expiration and reversion of such section as provided in section 4 of 13 chapter 656 of the laws of 2002, as amended.
