AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding two new sections 245.12 and 245.13 to read as follows:

18 19 § 245.12 Unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in the second degree.

1. A person is guilty of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in the second degree when, with intent to harass, annoy or alarm another person he or she sends by electronic device an unsolicited intimate image to such other person.

2. For purposes of this section, "intimate body parts" means the genitals, pubic area or anus of any person; "intimate image" means a photo-10 graph, film, videotape, recording or any other reproduction of an image of an individual with fully or partially exposed intimate body parts or engaged in sexual activity; "send by electronic device" means to send 14 using a cellular telephone or any other electronic communication device, including devices capable of sending text messages or e-mails; "sexual 16 activity" means "sexual intercourse" as defined in subdivision one of section 130.00 of this chapter, "oral sexual conduct" or "anal sexual conduct" as defined in subdivision two of section 130.00 of this chapter, touching of the intimate body parts of a person for the purpose of 20 gratifying sexual desire, sexual penetration with any object, or the 21 transmission or appearance of semen upon any part of the depicted indi-22 <u>vidual's body</u>.

Unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in the second degree is a 23 24 class A misdemeanor.

1 § 245.13 Unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in the first degree.

A person is guilty of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in 4 the first degree when he or she commits the crime of unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in the second degree, as defined in section 245.12 of this article, and discloses such intimate image to an individual sixteen years of age or younger.

Unsolicited disclosure of an intimate image in the first degree is a class E felony.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-11 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
