AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to providing the option to employees of electronic confirmation in lieu of paper pay stubs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 4 of section 200 of the state finance law is relettered paragraph (e) and two new paragraphs (c) and 3 (d) are added to read as follows:
- (c) Any employee who requests to have their salary deposited directly 5 in a bank pursuant to this section, may opt out of receiving a paper pay stub and may instead receive electronic confirmation of the information that would otherwise be included in the pay stub.
- 8 (d) The comptroller is hereby authorized to promulgate reasonable 9 rules and regulations, as may be necessary, to administer the electronic 10 confirmation referenced in paragraph (c) of this subdivision. The comp-11 troller shall provide notice of the electronic confirmation system in each employee's paper pay stub. 12
- 13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 14 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately the comptroller is 15 authorized to promulgate any rules and regulations and take any other 16 measures necessary to implement this act on its effective date.
