AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to extending the statute of limitations for claims resulting from unlawful discriminatory practices constituting sexual harassment to three years

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 297 of the executive law, as 2 amended by chapter 958 of the laws of 1968, is amended to read as 3 follows:

- 5. Any complaint filed pursuant to this section must be so filed within one year after the alleged unlawful discriminatory practice; provided that in cases of sexual harassment, the complaint must be so filed within three years after the alleged unlawful discriminatory practice.
- 8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 9 have become a law.
