AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including the impersonation of a doctor of medicine as criminal impersonation in the second degree

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 190.25 of the penal law is amended by adding a new  
2 subdivision 5 to read as follows:

3 5. Impersonates a doctor of medicine and, in so doing, the actor  
4 provides medical advice or treatment to another person as a patient,  
5 regardless of whether or not the other person suffers harm from the  
6 medical advice or treatment.

7 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding  
8 the date on which it shall have become a law.
