AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to enacting Vincent Scheppa's law authorizing, in certain cases, the provision of in-home private duty nursing services to a recipient of medical assistance by a relative who is a registered professional nurse

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Vincent 2 Scheppa's law".
- $\S$  2. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 365-o 4 to read as follows:
- 5 § 365-o. Provision of in-home private duty nursing services by the 6 relative of a recipient. Upon application or request to the commissioner 7 by a recipient of medical assistance, or his or her representative or 8 guardian, who has been approved for the provision of in-home private
- 9 <u>duty nursing, the commissioner may authorize the provision of such</u>
  10 <u>private duty nursing by an adult relative of such recipient, other than</u>
- 11 a spouse of the recipient, who is a registered professional nurse.
- 12 Reimbursement for private nursing services provided in accordance with
- 13 this section shall be at the rate paid for the provision of such
- 14 <u>services by a licensed practical nurse.</u>
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
