- AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to prohibiting state contracts with vendors that forbid employees from litigating discrimination or harassment claims

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 163 of the state finance law is amended by adding a 1 2 new subdivision 12-a to read as follows: 3 12-a. Certain contract provisions prohibited. a. No agency, depart-4 ment, division, board, bureau, or commission of the state shall enter 5 into contracts with any vendor that requires an employee or independent contractor performing work under such vendor's contract or subcontract 6 to submit claims arising under title VII of the civil rights act of 7 1964, article fifteen of the executive law, or any tort related to or 8 9 arising from discrimination, sexual assault or harassment, including: 10 assault, battery, intentional infliction of emotional distress, false imprisonment or negligent hiring, supervision or retention to private 11 arbitration for resolution; provided, however, that this paragraph shall 12 not apply to arbitration that is mandated by a collective bargaining 13 agreement between such vendor and employee and/or independent contrac-14 15 tor. 16 b. An agency, department, division, board, bureau, or commission of 17 the state can waive the requirements of paragraph a of this subdivision 18 when necessary to respond to an emergency arising from unforeseen causes

19 pursuant to paragraph b of subdivision ten of this section. The term of 20 the contract shall not be for longer than necessary to respond adequate-21 ly to the emergency. The agency, department, division, board, bureau, or
