AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to signatures for designating petitions for political subdivisions outside the city of New York; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 6-136 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

5. Notwithstanding subdivision two of this section, for designating 4 petitions for political subdivisions outside the city of New York, except for the position of member of ward, town, city or county committee, such petitions must be signed by not less than three and threeguarters per centum, as determined by the preceding enrollment, of the 8 then enrolled voters of the party residing within the political unit in 9 which the office or position is to be voted for (excluding voters in 10 inactive status). The reductions provided by subdivision four of this 11 section as added by chapter seventeen of the laws of two thousand nine-12 <u>teen shall also apply.</u>

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire December 14 31, 2019 when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed 15 repealed.
