AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to requiring the return of all or a part of the financial assistance provided for a project where the project has material shortfalls or material violations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 874 of the general municipal law, 2 as added by chapter 563 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as follows:

(11) Each agency shall develop policies for the return of all or a part of the financial assistance provided for the project, including all or part of the amount of any tax exemptions, as specified in the policy, which may include but shall not be limited to material shortfalls in job creation and retention projections or material violations of the terms and conditions of project agreements. The agency shall implement such 10 policies created in accordance with this subdivision to return all or part of the financial assistance provided for any project where the 12 agency's annual assessment of a project shows material shortfalls in job 13 creation and retention projections or material violations of the terms 14 and conditions of project agreements. All such returned amounts of tax 15 exemptions shall be redistributed to the appropriate affected tax jurisdiction, unless agreed to otherwise by any local taxing jurisdiction. § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
