AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to a program for the diagnosis and treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 7.17 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new subdivision (g) to read as follows:
- (g) The commissioner, in cooperation with any other state agency or relevant stakeholder shall develop a training program to be posted on the office's website for the diagnosis and treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder for military veterans. The program shall include a component on military culture competency and shall be intended for the training of mental health providers and mental health clinicians.
- 9 Certification of the completion of the program may be provided to
- 10 participants through the office.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
