AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring pharmacies to notify patients of certain drug recalls

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 6811-c 2 to read as follows:

§ 6811-c. Patient notification of recalled drugs. 1. For purposes of 4 this section the term "class I recall" shall mean a situation in which 5 the food and drug administration deems there is reasonable probability 6 that the use of or exposure to a violative product will cause serious adverse health consequences or death.

2. Where there has been a class I recall of a prescription drug, phar-9 macies shall notify all patients that have been prescribed and who are 10 currently taking such recalled drug dispensed from such pharmacy by 11 phone or by mail within seven days of such recall.

12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
