AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the sale of whipped cream chargers to persons under the age of twenty-one

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 399-ii to read as follows:

- § 399-ii. Sale of whipped cream chargers. 1. For purposes of this 4 section, the term "whipped cream charger" shall mean a steel cylinder or 5 cartridge filled with nitrous oxide (N2O) that is used as a whipping agent in a whipped cream dispenser, and is commonly referred to as a whippit, whippet, nossy, nang, Johnson or charger.
- 2. No person, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, 8 9 firm or any other business entity doing business within this state shall sell or offer for sale a whipped cream charger to any person under the 10 11 age of twenty-one.
- 3. Any person, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, 12 13 firm or any other business entity that violates the provisions of this 14 section shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than two hundred 15 fifty dollars for an initial offense and not more than five hundred 16 dollars for the second and each subsequent offense.
- 17 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
