AN ACT to amend chapter 510 of the laws of 2016, amending the tax law relating to the imposition of a hotel and motel tax in the town of Woodbury, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 510 of the laws of 2016, amending the tax law relating to the imposition of a hotel and motel tax in the town of Woodbury, is amended to read as follows:

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be deemed repealed [$\frac{3}{6}$] $\frac{6}{5}$ years after such date.
