AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Trooper Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Highway"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-i to read as follows:

§ 344-i. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Trooper Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Highway". A portion of the state highway system constituting state route four hundred fifteen in the county of Steuben, beginning at the intersection with the northern branch of Spaulding Drive and continuing in a generally southern direction, and terminating at the village of Bath municipal line, shall be designated and known as the "Trooper Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Highway".

11 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-12 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 13 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 14 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-15 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 16 ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be 17 changed as a result of this act.

18 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
