- AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Trooper Nicholas Clark Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-i to 2 read as follows: 3 § 344-i. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Trooper Nicholas Clark Memorial Bridge". The bridges on interstate 4 5 eighty-six which cross state route four hundred fifteen, designated б bridge numbers 1061621 and 1061622, in the county of Steuben, shall be 7 designated and known as the "Trooper Nicholas Clark Memorial Bridge". 8 § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 9 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 10 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.

15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
