AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Trooper Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-i to 2 read as follows:

- § 344-i. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Trooper Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Bridge". The bridges on interstate eighty-six which cross state route four hundred fifteen, designated bridge numbers 1061621 and 1061622, in the county of Steuben, shall be designated and known as the "Trooper Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Bridge".
- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-12 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 13 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 14 changed as a result of this act.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
