AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to eliminating unreasonable fees levied on tenants for reproductions of keys

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 2 235-i to read as follows:

§ 235-i. Unreasonable tenant fees for reproductions of keys. A landlord shall not charge a tenant a fee for the reproduction of keys to a
single dwelling greater than one hundred ten percent of the actual cost
of reproduction, provided such limitation shall not apply if a tenant
requires the reproduction of keys for a single dwelling more than three
times in a calendar year.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
