AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to certain increases in non-resident undergraduate rates of tuition for the state university of New York college of environmental science and forestry

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law is amended by adding a new subparagraph 4-a to read as follows: (4-a) Notwithstanding any law, rule, regulation, or practice to the contrary and following the review and approval of the chancellor of the state university or his or her designee, the board of trustees may raise non-resident undergraduate rates of tuition by not more than ten percent 7 over the tuition rates of the prior academic year for the state univer-8 sity of New York college of environmental science and forestry as 9 <u>defined in article one hundred twenty-one of this chapter for a four</u> 10 year period commencing with the two thousand twenty--two thousand twen-11 ty-one academic year and ending in the two thousand twenty-three--two 12 thousand twenty-four academic year provided that such rate change is 13 approved annually prior to board of trustees action by the chancellor of 14 the state university or his or her designee. § 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 15
