Introduced by Sen. PARKER -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Rules

AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the installation of safety belts in stretch limousines, and the posting of notice therein

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subdivision 1 of section 383 of the vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 86 of the laws of 1968, is amended and a new paragraph (d) is added to read as follows:

2 (c) A motor vehicle manufactured or assembled on or after January 3 first, nineteen hundred sixty-eight, at least one safety belt for each 4 passenger seat position~~[-]~~;

5 (d) An altered motor vehicle commonly referred to as a "stretch limousine" which was altered on or after January first, two thousand twenty,  
6 at least two safety belts for the front seat, and at least one safety  
7 belt for the rear seat for each passenger for which the rear seat of  
8 such vehicle was designed, and at least one safety belt for each passen-  
9 ger seat position.

10 § 2. Subdivision 4-b of section 383 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 11 added by chapter 495 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:

12 4-b. Taxicabs ~~[and]~~, liveries, and stretch limousines. All seat safety 13 belts installed in a taxicab or livery vehicle or in an altered motor  
14 vehicle commonly referred to as a "stretch limousine" pursuant to this 15 section shall be clearly visible, accessible and maintained in good 16 working order, and no seat safety belt installed in such taxicab or 17 livery vehicle or altered motor vehicle shall be removed therefrom.

18 § 3. Subdivision 51 of section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law, as 19 added by chapter 495 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:

20 51. Taxicab ~~[and]~~, livery and stretch limousine notices. (a) Every 21 taxicab ~~[and]~~, livery, and altered motor vehicle commonly referred to as

1 a "stretch limousine" which was altered on or after January first, two  
2 thousand twenty registered in this state shall have posted therein the  
3 following notice: "Seatbelts must be available for your use. Please  
4 buckle up."

5 (b) The notices required to be posted pursuant to paragraph (a) of  
6 this subdivision shall be posted in a manner legible and conspicuous to  
7 passengers in all seating positions of such vehicles.

8 § 4. This act shall take effect January 1, 2020. Effective immediate-  
9 ly, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation  
10 necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are  
11 authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
