AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to the power to revoke or suspend the license of a real estate broker or salesman

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 441-c of the real property law, as amended by chapter 81 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The department of state may revoke the license of a real estate 5 broker or salesman or suspend the same, for such period as the department may deem proper, or in lieu thereof may impose a fine not exceeding 7 one thousand dollars payable to the department of state, or a reprimand upon conviction of the licensee of a violation of any provision of this article, or for a material misstatement in the application for such 10 license, or if such licensee has been quilty of fraud or fraudulent 11 practices, or for dishonest or misleading advertising, or has demonstrated untrustworthiness or incompetency to act as a real estate broker 12 13 or salesman, or for a violation of the human rights law committed in his 14 or her capacity as a real estate broker or salesman, as the case may be. 15 In the case of a real estate broker engaged in the business of a tenant 16 relocator, untrustworthiness or incompetency shall include engaging in 17 any course of conduct including, but not limited to, the interruption or 18 discontinuance of essential building service, that interferes with or 19 disturbs the peace, comfort, repose and quiet enjoyment of a tenant. 20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
