AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to prohibiting the paying of ransom in the event of a cyber-attack

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general municipal law is amended by adding a new section 70-b to read as follows:

§ 70-b. Payment of ransom; cyber-attack. No municipal corporation or other government entity shall pay ransom in the event of a cyber-attack against such municipal corporation or such government entity. As used in this section the term "cyber-attack" shall mean a virtual attack against the critical infrastructure, as defined in subdivision five of section eighty-six of the public officers law, of a municipal corporation or other government entity.

§ 2. This act shall tale effect immediately.
