AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to establishing a restaurant meals program as part of the supplemental nutrition assistance program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 95 of the social services law is amended by adding
2 a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:

3 11. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
4 the office shall establish a restaurant meals program as part of SNAP.
5 Under the restaurant meals program, households containing elderly or
6 disabled members, and their spouses, as defined in 7 U.S.C. 2012(j), or
7 homeless individuals, as defined in 7 U.S.C. 2012(l), shall have the
8 option in accordance with 7 U.S.C. 2012(k) to redeem their SNAP benefits
9 at private establishments that contract with the office to offer meals
10 for eligible individuals at concessional prices subject to 7 U.S.C.
11 2018(h).

12 (b) The office shall adopt any rules necessary to implement the
13 provisions of this subdivision.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding
15 the date on which it shall have become a law.
