AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to an exemption from certain vaccination requirements for school attendance based upon religious beliefs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2164 of the public health law is amended by adding
a new subdivision 9 to read as follows:

9. This section shall not apply to children whose parent, parents, or quardian hold genuine and sincere religious beliefs which are contrary to the practices herein required, and no certificate shall be required as a prerequisite to such children being admitted or received into school or attending school.

8 § 2. Subdivision 6 of section 2164 of the public health law, as 9 amended by chapter 35 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as 10 follows:

11 6. In the event that a person in parental relation to a child makes 12 application for admission of such child to a school or has a child attending school and there exists no certificate or other acceptable evidence of the child's immunization against poliomyelitis, mumps, 13 14 15 measles, diphtheria, rubella, varicella, hepatitis B, pertussis, teta-16 nus, and, where applicable, Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib), meningococcal disease, and pneumococcal disease, the principal, teacher, 17 18 owner or person in charge of the school shall inform such person of the necessity to have the child immunized, that such immunization may be 19 administered by any health practitioner, or that the child may be immun-20 21 ized without charge by the health officer in the county where the child 22 resides, if such person executes a consent therefor. In the event that 23 such person does not wish to select a health practitioner to administer 24 the immunization, he or she shall be provided with a form which shall 25 give notice that as a prerequisite to processing the application for 26 admission to, or for continued attendance at, the school such person 27 shall state a valid reason for withholding consent or consent shall be

6 § 3. Paragraph (f) of subdivision 5 of section 2168 of the public 7 health law, as amended by chapter 35 of the laws of 2019, is amended to 8 read as follows:

9 (f) The immunization status of children exempt from immunizations 10 pursuant to subdivision eight of section twenty-one hundred sixty-four 11 of this title <u>and a parent claiming exemption pursuant to subdivision</u> 12 <u>nine of section twenty-one hundred sixty-four of this title</u> shall be 13 reported by the health care provider.

14 § 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
