AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to providing that tuition for the state university of New York and the city university of New York shall not be increased for certain academic years

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Clause (ii) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law, as amended by section 1 of part 2 JJJ of chapter 59 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows: (ii) Commencing with the two thousand seventeen -- two thousand eighteen academic year and ending in the two thousand twenty--two thousand twenty-one academic year the state university of New York board of trustees shall be empowered to increase the resident undergraduate rate of 8 tuition by not more than two hundred dollars over the resident undergraduate rate of tuition adopted by the board of trustees in the prior 10 academic year, provided, however, that beginning in academic year two 11 thousand twenty--two thousand twenty-one and ending in academic year two thousand twenty-four--two thousand twenty-five, the annual rate of 12 13 tuition shall not be increased, provided further, however, that if the 14 annual resident undergraduate rate of tuition would exceed five thousand dollars, then a tuition credit for each eligible student, as determined and calculated by the New York state higher education services corpo-16 ration pursuant to section six hundred eighty-nine-a of this title, 17 shall be applied toward the tuition charged for each semester, quarter 18 19 or term of study and such cost shall be provided to the state university 20 of New York through state general fund operating support. Tuition for 21 each semester, quarter or term of study shall not be due for any student eligible to receive such tuition credit until the tuition credit is 22 23 calculated and applied against the tuition charged for the corresponding 24 semester, quarter or term. [Provided, further that the revenue resulting 25 from an increase in the rate of tuition shall be allocated to each

campus pursuant to a plan approved by the board of trustees to support investments in new classroom faculty, instruction, initiatives to improve student success and on-time completion and a tuition credit for each eligible student.

- § 2. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 to the education law, as amended by section 2 of part JJJ of chapter 59 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (ii) Commencing with the two thousand seventeen--two thousand eighteen 9 academic year and ending in the two thousand twenty--two thousand twen-10 ty-one academic year the city university of New York board of trustees 11 shall be empowered to increase the resident undergraduate rate of tuition by not more than two hundred dollars over the resident under-12 13 graduate rate of tuition adopted by the board of trustees in the prior 14 academic year, provided however, that beginning in academic year two 15 thousand twenty--two thousand twenty-one and ending in academic year two 16 thousand twenty-four--two thousand twenty-five, the annual rate of 17 tuition shall not be increased, provided further, however, that if the annual resident undergraduate rate of tuition would exceed five thousand 18 dollars, then a tuition credit for each eligible student, as determined 19 20 and calculated by the New York state higher education services corpo-21 ration pursuant to section six hundred eighty-nine-a of this title, 22 shall be applied toward the tuition charged for each semester, quarter or term of study and such cost shall be provided to the city university 23 24 of New York through state general fund operating support. Tuition for 25 each semester, quarter or term of study shall not be due for any student 26 eligible to receive such tuition credit until the tuition credit is 27 calculated and applied against the tuition charged for the corresponding 28 semester, quarter or term. [Provided, further that the revenue resulting from an increase in the rate of tuition shall be allocated to each 29 30 campus pursuant to a plan approved by the board of trustees to support 31 investments in new classroom faculty, instruction, initiatives to 32 improve student success and on-time completion and a tuition credit for 33 each eligible student.
  - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, that:
  - 1. the amendments to clause (ii) of subparagraph 4 of paragraph h of subdivision 2 of section 355 of the education law made by section one of this act shall not affect the expiration of such subparagraph and shall expire therewith; and
- 2. the amendments to subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 7 of section 6206 of the education law made by section two of this act shall not affect the expiration of such paragraph and shall expire therewith.
