- AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring the state board of elections to develop a program to be administered by all boards of elections to notify voters of certain information where their area has been redistricted

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## 1 Section 1. Section 3-102 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 16-b to read as follows:

3 <u>16-b. develop a program to be administered by all boards of elections</u> 4 <u>to notify voters that their districts may have changed due to redis-</u> 5 <u>tricting. Such program shall include but not be limited to mailings,</u> 6 <u>online, telephone or other resources to assist voters in determining</u> 7 <u>potential representatives for their district prior to an election;</u>

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately. The state board of 9 elections shall amend or promulgate pertinent rules and regulations as 10 necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
