- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the incineration of aqueous film-forming foam containing perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new section 27-0927 to read as follows: <u>§ 27-0927. Incineration of aqueous film-forming foam containing perfluo-</u> roalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances prohibited.

5 <u>1. The disposal by incineration of aqueous film-forming foam that</u> 6 <u>contains perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances shall be prohib-</u> 7 <u>ited in the state of New York. The commissioner may promulgate any rules</u> 8 <u>or regulations he or she may deem necessary in order to carry out the</u> 9 <u>provisions of this section.</u>

10 2. For the purposes of this section:

(a) "incineration" includes but is not limited to burning, combustion, pyrolysis, gasification, thermal oxidation (including flameless and regenerative), acid recovery furnace/oxidizer, ore roaster, cement kiln, lightweight aggregate kiln, industrial furnace, boiler and process heater; and

16 (b) "perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances" means a class of 17 fluorinated organic chemicals containing at least one fully fluorinated

18 <u>carbon atom.</u>

19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
