AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to excluding deer management professionals retained by the incorporated village of Lloyd Harbor

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 5 of section 11-0931 of the 2 environmental conservation law is amended to read as follows:

- a. No person shall use a rifle for hunting on Long Island or in Westdester County. If a person [be] is found carrying a rifle in the woodlands on Long Island or in Westchester County, that fact shall be
  presumptive evidence that he or she is illegally using it for hunting in
  that area[ but this]. This provision does not apply to: (1) members of
  a duly organized target shooting club carrying unloaded rifles to and
  from the target range; and (2) deer management professionals retained by
  the incorporated village of Lloyd Harbor acting within the boundaries of
  the village.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
