AN ACT to require airlines and travel insurance companies to provide refunds for travel cancelled due to coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all airlines and travel insurance companies shall provide a full refund, without any penalty in the form of deduction of fees and regardless of any contractual cancellation period, to any resident of the state of New York who cancels travel due to coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- 6 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
