AN ACT to amend chapter 405 of the laws of 2007, amending the tax law relating to increasing hotel/motel taxes in Chautauqua county, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 405 of the laws of 2007, amending the tax law relating to increasing hotel/motel taxes in Chautauqua county, as amended by section 1 of subpart B of part B of chapter 61 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

- 5 § 2. This act shall take effect December 1, 2007 and shall expire and 6 be deemed repealed November 30, $[\frac{2020}{2020}]$ 2023.
- 7 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
