AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring certain notices to be provided when selling a helicopter

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
243-a to read as follows:
§ 243-a. Sale of helicopters. No person shall sell a helicopter within
the state without providing to the purchaser a notice which contains all
incidents reported within the past ten years by the national transporta tion safety bureau or the federal aviation administration involving the
make and model, or a substantially similar make and model, of such heli copter.
§ 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
have become a law.
