The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. Section 591 of the labor law is amended by adding a new
2	subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
3	2-a. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, benefits
4	shall be paid to any employee who is under mandatory or voluntary quar-
5	antine as a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19). Claimants shall not be
6	required to participate in reemployment services or use vacation time
7	while under guarantine.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 9 deemed repealed two years after such date.
