AN ACT relating to authorizing local code enforcement officers to issue blanket orders to extend the expiration date for all active building permits for a period of up to 120 days

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 1202.2 of title 19 of the New York State code, rules and regulations, local code enforcement officers may issue blanket orders extending the expiration date for all active building permits for a period of up to but not exceeding 120 days beyond the expiration date stated in the permit. Additionally, local zoning boards of appeals and local planning boards may issue blanket orders extending the expiration date for all outstanding active approvals for a period of up to but not exceeding 120 days.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
