AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing a program to incentivize unemployed individuals to enter jobs in healthcare

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 59 to read as follows:
- 59. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the commissioner, in conjunction with the commissioner of health and the commissioner of labor shall establish a program which incentivizes unemployed individuals to enter jobs in healthcare, including but not limited to, certified nurse aides. Such incentives shall include, but not be limited to, expedited training and certification processes for such healthcare positions as determined by the commissioner.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
