AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to establishing a tax exemption for an active volunteer firefighter and a volunteer ambulance worker

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 612 of the tax law is amended by
adding a new paragraph 42 to read as follows:
(42) For the taxable year two thousand twenty, any income received by

4 an individual who served as an active volunteer firefighter as defined 5 in subdivision one of section two hundred fifteen of the general munici-6 pal law or as a volunteer ambulance worker as defined in subdivision 7 fourteen of section two hundred nineteen-k of the general municipal law 8 for the entire taxable year of two thousand twenty, to the extent inclu-9 dible in gross income for federal income tax purposes, but not to exceed

10 fifteen thousand dollars.
